Before joining a Zoom meeting on a computer or mobile device, you can download the Zoom app from Zoom's <u>Download Center</u> (<u>https://zoom.us/download</u>). Otherwise, you will be prompted to download and install Zoom when you click an invitation link. You do not need a Zoom account to join a meeting. You will be prompted to enter a display name when you join the meeting.

The Zoom meeting will open in a window and will show the current speaker. In the top right corner of the display, there are view options to select viewing all the participants in a gallery or to highlight just the speaker. Along the bottom of the screen, there are options to enable or disable your microphone and video, if available. There is also a chat feature which will let you type comments to share with others.

Zoom has a <u>Help Center</u> (<u>https://support.zoom.us/</u>) with additional tutorials if you would like to learn more. In addition, Zoom offers free basic accounts if you would like to create a meeting of your own to explore options.
